NORTHWOOD LAKE WATER QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Dear Resident:

The Bassett Creek Watershed Management Commission (Commission) and the City of Plymouth are reviewing water quality improvement alternatives for Northwood Lake. Previously, a stream restoration and water quality ponding project was proposed between Lancaster and Pilgrim Lanes to repair eroded channels and provide water quality treatment. Subsequently, a neighborhood meeting in June of 2013 resulted in an additional stream restoration concept.

An open house is scheduled for January 29, 2015 from 7:00pm to 8:30pm in the Medicine Lake Room at Plymouth City Hall, 3400 Plymouth Blvd., Plymouth, MN, 55447. The two stream restoration concepts as well as a flocculation system concept will be available for review. If you cannot make this meeting but would like to discuss the project please contact me directly.

A water quality improvement project is being considered in this area to reduce nutrient loading downstream to Northwood Lake and assist the City of Plymouth in meeting required water quality improvements.
