Dear Resident:

The City of Plymouth is working to design drainage improvements to improve water flow and flood protection within three neighborhoods: Ivanhoe/Pheasant Hills, French Ridge Park, and St. Mary's. Included with this correspondence is a notice of application requesting confirmation of wetland boundaries from various regulatory authorities. It will be followed in a few weeks with a notice of decision confirming the wetland boundaries. This information is necessary for future project permitting.

In addition, a neighborhood information meeting is scheduled for August 15, 2018 from 4-6pm in the Medicine Lake Room at Plymouth City Hall, 3400 Plymouth Blvd., Plymouth, MN, 55447. Draft plans will be available for review and the design team and City staff will be available to answer questions and take comments.
