April 10 Kickoff meeting for Our 26th Year - 9:00

Meet at the Plymouth Creek Center, 14800 34th Street, for the 2018 PPBC Kickoff Meeting and our 25th year. (Weather permitting, we will take a 10 mile Lite/Regular club ride around Plymouth - Leader: John Heibel.)

April 17 Minneapolis Riverfront from Cedar Lake

Meet at the Triangle Park - Drew Ave. So. & Cedar Shore Dr. near Cedar Lake. 3501 W 24th St. Combined Lite Group and Regular Group. The ride will go around the west and north sides of Cedar Lake onto the North Cedar Lake Regional Trail to the river. We'll ride across the Hennepin Ave. Bridge, stop for refreshments at the Wilde Roast Cafe, cross the Stone Arch Bridge and return to the North Cedar Lake Trail and Cedar Lake. Trail: Paved bike paths and low-traffic city streets. Distance is approximately 15 miles. Directions: To the parking area -- take TH 55 to Theo. Wirth Pkwy., go south on Theo Wirth to Cedar Lake. Pkwy., take Cedar Lake Pkwy to 22nd Street, go right on 22nd one block to So. Drew Ave., go left on Drew for one block to a small park at Drew Ave. and Cedar Shore Dr.) ([Start Location](#))

April 24 Dakota Trail - Wayzata to Mound

Meet at the beach house parking lot in Wayzata - 238 Grove Lane East, Wayzata, MN. Ride on the Dakota Rail Regional Trail from Wayzata to Mound. We will stop for refreshments in Mound and then return to Wayzata. Trail: Level on paved rail bed, about 18 miles roundtrip. Direction: Take County Rd 15 (Lake Street) west through Wayzata to Grove Lane, turn left and follow Grove to the parking area. ([Start Location](#))

May 1 West Mpls/First Ring Suburbs Parks

Meet at Basset Creek Park, 6001 32 Ave N, Crystal. We'll ride over Hwy 100 at 39 St. to Lee Park in Robbinsdale. Then through Sochacki Park, Theodore Wirth Park and around Cedar Lake. Returning through Theodore Wirth Park and Schaper Park. About 16 miles. Trail: mostly trails with a few gentle hills. Directions: From Hwy 100 take 36th Ave N west to Douglas Dr, go south on Douglas Dr. to 32nd Ave N, go east on 32nd to the park. Park near dog park.) ([Start Location](#))

May 8 Nicollet Mall - New Ride

Meet at the Triangle Park - Drew Ave. So & Cedar Shore Dr. near Cedar Lake. 3501 W. 24th St. The ride will begin at Cedar Lake and head to Loring Park. We'll take the Loring Greenway to the Nicollet Mall. We'll ride down the Mall and take in the downtown sights on our way to the river. We'll ride along the Mississippi River Trail, and take it all the way to the Greenway. From there, we'll return to Cedar by way of the Greenway with a stop for coffee at Isles and Buns. About 17 miles. Mostly paved trails, mostly flat. Directions: To the parking area -- take TH 55 to Theo. Wirth Pkwy., go south on Theo Wirth to Cedar Lake. Pkwy., take Cedar Lake Pkwy to 22nd Street, go right on 22nd one block to So. Drew Ave., go left on Drew for one block to a small park at Drew Ave. and Cedar Shore Dr.) ([Start Location](#))

May 15 Cottagewood to the Minnesota Arboretum

Meet at Cottagewood parking area in Deephaven, near 20231 Cottagewood Road. Ride along the Lake Minnetonka Regional Trail through Excelsior to Arboretum Blvd. Enter the Arboretum and ride the "Three Mile Drive" loop. Stop for coffee at the Arboretum café. Return on the trail along Hwy 41. . Level limestone and paved trails, but hilly in the Arboretum. About 19 miles. From I-494, exit at Minnetonka Blvd and proceed west 2.8 miles (going past Hwy 101) to stop sign. Turn left (still on Mtka. Blvd.) go 2.2 miles past Carson Bay, and then right on Cottagewood Road for about 400 feet. - Parking is on the left. ([Start Location Map](#))

May 22 Lunch Ride to Surly and Witches Hat - 10:00

Meet at the Triangle Park - Drew Ave. So. & Cedar Shore Dr. near Cedar Lake. 3501 W 24th St. Ride the North Cedar Lake Regional Trail to the Mississippi river, tour Nicollet Island, and then take the U of M trail to the Witch's Hat and Surly's for lunch. From Surly's ride to the Franklin Ave. bridge, ride through the Seward neighborhood to the Greenway and back to Cedar Lake. Level paved bike trails and low traffic city streets. 20 miles. Take Hwy 55 to Theodor Wirth Parkway, go south on Theo Wirth to Cedar Lake Pkwy., take Cedar Lake Pkwy to 22nd Street, go right on 22nd one block to South Drew Ave., go left on Drew for one block to the park ([Start Location](#))
